

## Directions for Map

1. Navigate to [www.vermontreefarm.org](http://www.vermontreefarm.org)
2. Click on button for Tree Farm Map and Management Activities Database
  - a. If you do not see this link, then either refresh your page, or take a minute and clear your cookies!
  - b. Sometimes, simply selecting the refresh button on your browser bar, also helps to reset the map.
3. Scroll down page and click on the red words or on the map to open in a new tab.
4. You will see entire State of Vermont, the brown shapes all over the map are Tree Farms
  - a. The Tree Farms look brown when far away, but almost more orange when really close.
5. Everyone likes to have their maps displayed differently. Just like in navigation apps you may use for directions, you are able to select what type of Basemap to use.
  - a. In the upper left hand corner, select your Basemap of choice. There are many choices, it really depends upon your own personal preferences.
  - b. I am going to choose the USA Topo maps- in this one you can see elevation contours under the actual Tree Farm property boundary.
6. Use the + or – buttons to zoom in or out and make it larger or smaller to find the Tree Farm . You may also use the scroll button on your mouse, or pinch your fingers on your mousepad to enlarge .
  - a. Moving around the map is easy by just a click and drag with your mousepad or mouse.
7. The search bar may be used to search for a town location or specific address.
  - a. As you type the address, it automatically drops down more addresses
  - b. You may either pick one of the addresses that drop down , or type it. Sometimes, you have to use the refresh button when entering a specific address. It will then zoom in more closely to the selected location.
8. Click on the property you wish to identify and a box will open with information on that Tree Farm.
  - a. Scroll on the side of the box, and there are either directions to the Tree Farm or an address.
9. You may also choose to share this map on Facebook or Twitter, or you have the ability to print. These choices are on the toolbar next to the Location search box. Just follow the directions to complete.
10. How to print:
  - a. Click on drop down menu to choose map or map with legend. Use your printer to print!
11. The buttons on the top right bar are for administrators, only.

### For Foresters:

- a. If you would like to measure a distance or size of a parcel, click on the Measure box, next to the search bar.
- b. The box to the left is area
  - i. All the way to the right to choose either: acres, square miles, square kilometers, hectares, square yards, square feet, or square meters
  - ii. Click where to start measuring, drag mouse to different points, and ending where you began to give an acreage amount.
- c. Box in middle is distance
  - i. Again choose unit of measure in drop down menu to the right
  - ii. Click to start measuring, and click to stop. The result will be in the white box.
- d. Last box is either latitude and longitude in degrees or DMS(degrees, minutes, seconds)
  - i. This is just a point on the map
- e. Exit by clicking the X in upper right hand corner
